TIERED PRICING?

We believe in the immense value of a Christian camp experience for everyone. Because of this, we strive to keep camp as affordable as possible while still providing a high-quality experience.

Tiered pricing provides our standard low cost option, while also presenting the actual costs of camp for those who can afford it.

All campers receive the same high quality camp experience regardless of what tier they pay, and all families are free to choose the option that works best for them. Your selection is completely confidential.

When you register, simply choose the tier that works best for your family:

- **Tier A** prices most accurately reflect the true cost of a camp experience, including staffing, meals, supplies, programming, and building maintenance.
- **Tier B** is a partially subsidized rate. This tier covers basic program expenses, but is partially supported by donors.
- **Tier C** is our historically subsidized rate. **We want everyone to be able to come to camp**, so we keep this rate as low as possible.

This change offers the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of a camp experience. We will also continue to offer scholarships through our financial aid program.

ACTIVITY FEES?

As part of our switch to tiered pricing, we are removing any additional fees that were once a part of the summer camp experience. Optional activities such as Horses or the Bike Trip are now **INCLUDED** as part of your registration.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

How to Register

Registration opens on **Monday, February 3rd at 9:00 am EST**. Prior to this date you will be able to log in to your online account but will NOT be able to select any camp sessions. Register online at lakeviewministries.camp.

Deposit and Payments

A \$100 deposit is required for all Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages sessions. A \$25 deposit (per person) is required for Family sessions. Only a completed registration with a deposit will hold your spot. **Full payment for your camp session is REQUIRED two weeks prior to your scheduled arrival.**

Registration Confirmation

Upon registering, you will receive an email confirming your registration. **Please contact our office if you do not.** Once registered, log in to your online account to view and PRINT a required Medical Form and Camp Information Form (which includes arrival/departure info and a pack list). These will be available in the "Download Forms" section of your online account. **These forms will NOT be mailed to you. The Medical Form can NOT be filled out online.**

Wait List

If your first choice session is full, registering will add you to the wait list for that session. (You will not need to pay a deposit.) When a spot becomes available, we offer it to those on the wait list in order of initial sign up. You will have limited time to respond to our offer before we move on to the next person on the list. **Make sure the email and phone number associated with your account are ones you check regularly.** NO EXCEPTIONS are made to wait list order.

Grade Level

All grade levels are based on the camper's current (2019-2020) school year.

Cabin Mate Requests

Please minimize requests as much as possible. We value giving campers the space to make new friends. We will do our best to honor up to FIVE cabin mate requests, **but prefer only ONE or TWO**. Cabin mates must mutually choose each other for requests to be honored.

Financial Aid

Financial aid is available to help with the cost of camp. We want EVERYONE to be able to come to camp, regardless of financial situation. Go to lakeviewministries.camp/financialaid to download the request form.

Cancellation Policy

Refunds will be granted 14 days prior to your scheduled arrival for all but \$25 of your deposit. No refunds will be granted within 14 days of your scheduled arrival except in cases of illness, injury or family emergencies.

Multiple Sessions

Due to the high demand for Camp Lakeview and Lakeview Villages sessions, campers may initially only register for one of these sessions. After **March 1st** campers may register for an additional session.

Moving our offices will also allow us to install entry gates at the top of the hill, letting us welcome campers and visitors as they arrive and helping us keep camp secure.

All of these happenings at camp are very exciting, but we are most excited about the opportunity to serve your family and welcome your child to camp! We strive to provide experiences for kids (and adults) to grow, to be inspired, and to have fun. We believe camp is a unique place where God uses these experiences to bring us closer to one another and (most importantly) closer to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
