ASSISTANT MAINTENANCE JOB DESCRIPTION

Required Qualifications

- 1. Minimum age -18 years old.
- 2. Legal Driver's License and ability to operate vehicles, mowers, weed eaters, etc.
- 3. Ability to lift and carry tables, chairs, and other equipment up to ~80 pounds.
- 4. Ability to lead and supervise volunteers, seasonal staff, and junior staff.
- 5. Desire and ability to work in a camp setting.

Desired Qualifications

- 1. Member in good standing of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.
- 2. Organized and self-motivated, with the initiative to find work that needs to be done.
- 3. Ability to work well with others.
- 4. Possess imagination, a sense of humor, patience, conviction, sincerity, enthusiasm, initiative, self-control, adaptability, willingness to learn, integrity, ingenuity, a sense of spiritual direction, and the presence of God in his/her life.

To Whom Responsible

The Director of Facilities in terms of training and work assignments, as well as personnel policies, and performance review.

General Responsibilities

- 1. To maintain the grounds and facilities of Lakeview Ministries to ensure a safe, healthy, attractive, and functional environment.
- 2. To work under and with the Director of Facilities to prioritize and assist with tasks that would be a greater benefit to the overall mission of Lakeview Ministries.
- 3. Return equipment and supplies to their proper storage areas and maintain in a neat and orderly condition.
- 4. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives within you and that you view your position as an opportunity to be in His service.

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Specific Responsibilities

- 1. Help with any groundwork that may need to be done such as mowing, trimming, repairs to outdoor furniture, collecting trash, trimming trails, splitting and stacking firewood, and snow removal.
- 2. Assist with building maintenance such as: changing filters; check and replace faulty smoke detectors and fire extinguishers; repair electrical, plumbing, or HVAC problems, and call in professional assistance when needed; repair items such as screens, windows, doors, hinges, door knobs, gutters, lightbulbs, etc.; and assist with construction or remodeling of buildings.
- 3. Assist with maintaining equipment on camp including, but not limited to: beds, dressers, showers, commodes, sinks, tables, chairs, docks, canoes, sport equipment, challenge course elements, etc.
- 4. Provide preventative care and emergency repairs on camp's fleet of vehicles such as the tractor, pickups, vans, etc. This also includes the small engine equipment such as mowers, trimmers, etc.
- 5. Maintain all hand tools and power tools in good working order.
- 6. Assist in moving materials and supplies to appropriate areas of camp as needed.
- 7. Assist in cleaning and preparing facilities for the arrival of guest groups.
- 8. Work with the Director of Facilities to make sure that all maintenance and cleaning products are fully stocked and distributed around camp to their needed locations.
- 9. Assist in coordinating and leading seasonal staff and volunteers with work projects.
- 10. Attend required staff meetings as needed or requested by the Director of Facilities.
- 11. Continually evaluate current operations, explore and implement improvements.
- 12. Communicate with the Director of Facilities to share concerns, improvements or recommendations.
- 13. As a team member, assist other staff in any task that will enhance the outdoor ministry of Lakeview Ministry.
