

Dear Camp Family,

With our eyes held steadfast on our Lord and Savior, we look forward to the day when we can meet face to face once again. As everyone is adjusting to this new routine, we know that many kids are eagerly awaiting their summer at camp now more than ever. You likely have questions about this summer and the impact of COVID-19 on Lakeview Ministries. We want to be as open as possible with you about what's been happening at camp and how we're preparing for this summer. It's important you know the challenges we're facing, but also the hope we're holding onto. With that in mind, please be aware of the following items that shape our **Plan of Action** moving forward:

- **3 weeks** prior to the start of each camp session, we will announce whether that session is a "Go" or a "No Go". Our desire is to offer as many weeks of camp as we can, and this approach will allow us the greatest flexibility to do that.
- There are **4 major checkpoints** we must reach in order to run summer camp programs:
 - Group Gathering Regulations
 - Operational Regulations,
 - Camper/Staff Care
 - Camp Logistics

Each of these checkpoints contain many decision factors spelled out in greater detail on our website.

- In the unfortunate event that your session is cancelled, we will send you an email with a form to instruct us on how to handle your registration payments. This form will allow you to request a **refund** or **donate** all or a portion of your payment to Lakeview Ministries.
- Please be praying for Lakeview Ministries as we navigate the impact this pandemic is having on our ministry. We have already lost income from spring guest group cancellations and are facing the possibility of losing income from all or part of the summer. Summer camp income makes up over 60% of our annual revenue. The outcome of the next few months could be devastating to our ministry.
