

PLAN OF ACTION FOR SUMMER 2020

June 1st SUMMARY UPDATE

- We announced last Wednesday, May 27th that we were CANCELLING normal camp programs for Summer 2020. You can find more information about this difficult decision [HERE](#).
- The initial response to our summer cancellation has been encouraging:
 - We have received nearly **900 responses** to the cancellation survey directing us how to handle the registration payments.
 - Nearly **50%** of families have been able to donate all or a portion of their payments.

These donations will help camp survive this pandemic and allow us to provide opportunities for your family to enjoy camp in the future. If you had a camper registered for camp this summer and have not filled out the cancellation survey, you can find it here: [SUMMER CANCELLATION SURVEY](#)

- We are planning on offering **alternative camp programs** for families and children this summer.
- Beginning **Monday, June 8th**, we will be allowing families and small groups to rent one of our Village Clusters during the week or weekend.
 - Rentals for each group will include the entire village cluster, which includes 4 cabins, a bathhouse with showers, a residential style kitchen, and a covered picnic area.
 - Total group size at each cluster will be limited to 20 individuals.
 - The waterfront will be open and available to use with modifications to provide for social distancing.
 - Limited programming options will be available to schedule/use as an individual group.

- We are continuing to analyze camp's financial situation.
 - In our first analysis of camp being canceled, we were anticipating a loss of nearly \$400,000.
 - Our PPP loan through the Cares Act as well as registration deposits being converted to donations will help with this anticipated loss, but there will still be a significant impact due to the cancellation of summer programs.
 - We will need additional resources in order to cover our expenses for the rest of the year.
